CLASSICAL BALLET

EncoreBallet offers classical ballet lessons that will nurture and encourage each individual, teaching strength, grace, discipline, agility and musicality, and boosting self-esteem and confidence. Ms Lisa teaches all classes, ensuring continuity and a clear sense of progress throughout a student's training. To deliver a fully rounded experience and achievable goals each year, students will have the opportunity to take exams and to be part of EncoreBallet's annual performance. Open classes are held at the end of the winter and summer term to give parents the chance to view their child's progress. Certificates that acknowledge and celebrate course completion are presented to students in June.

We follow the Royal Academy of Dance (RAD) Grade and Vocational Ballet syllabus, which offers a quality learning experience for all ages and the flexibility to study for different types of exams to suit each student. Certificates and medals are awarded to successful candidates and higher-level exam candidates can use their result to contribute to their UCAS points tariff. Exams are not mandatory but we believe in giving students the opportunity to express themselves, realise their talents and feel a sense of achievement through the challenge of an exam goal. Many of Ms Lisa's students have reached the highest grade and vocational exam levels, achieving excellent results. Ms Lisa Mower graduated from the Royal Ballet School Teacher's Training Course in 1997 and has over 25 years' teaching experience working with students aged 2-18 and adults.

RISING STARS/LITTLE STARS

Classes are built on the foundations of classical ballet technique and combined with storytelling, creative movement and lots of imagination. Key gross motor skills such as balance, co-ordination and core strength, which are so important for a child's physical development, are used throughout the lessons. Familiar themes, a wide range of musical styles and the use of various props keeps students engaged and active!

PRIMARY/SHINING STARS

Lessons become more structured but movement skills are still performed and perfected with lots of imagery and fun props to a wide variety of music. Class awards and exams may be taken at these levels if we feel the student is ready and will benefit from the experience.

GRADE 1/2

Official ballet terminology is gradually introduced through the grades, with a greater emphasis on technique and performance qualities as the levels increase. Free work is regularly taught alongside syllabus work to maintain students' ability to perform any combinations of steps and to ensure classes are inspiring and fun.

SKILLS CLASS LEVEL 1/2

Lessons focus on classical ballet technical elements to enhance each student's level of performance. Classes are designed and choreographed by Ms Lisa, drawing on her background at the Royal Ballet School and many years of teaching experience. These lessons are not syllabus based, but are structured to complement a student's progression through graded and vocational levels.

Remarks

- Students may take the exams with the Royal Academy of Dance (RAD) and successful candidates will be awarded certificates and medals.
- Examinations to be co-ordinated by coach. Applications are confirmed in January and then date of exam is usually scheduled for the start of June.
- Students will be required to attend classes for the full academic year to be considered for an examination.
- Students will be awarded certificates from EncoreBallet, the dancing school, upon completion of the course. Final class in December will be presentation week and parents are invited to attend the class to see their child's progress.
- Correct uniform should be worn to class. Details for requirements including colours/styles are available on the dance school website.
- Students may consider purchasing the dancing uniform through the dancing school. This is not compulsory but those who are interested may order through the website of the school or contact coach in person.
- No cancellation will be accepted once the application is confirmed.
- No refunds will be issued for classes missed. Students travelling out of Hong Kong, on school camp or attending a compulsory school event preventing their attendance can apply for class cancellation refund. Proof of travel or a letter from school must be provided for the relevant dates. A maximum of two dates may be selected per term.
- Participants who miss a lesson due to illness will be offered a make up class option if they are able to provide a doctor's certificate.
- Drop-in is allowed and course fee will be paid pro rata. Applications after half term to be discussed with coach.
